Use of Motorised Buggies Policy

1. Use of Motorised Buggies is the responsibility of the Course Supervisor or delegate, who will check daily the course condition to determine if any restrictions are required. This information will be displayed on the club website to advise all golfers (members & visitors) of any restrictions imposed.
2. Each buggy driver will be asked to read a list of 'Buggy Use Instructions' and be given a copy of these instructions before being allowed to drive on the course. The driver will sign a record book indicating that they have read and understood the instructions. Any member or visitor who intends to use their personally owned buggy must be required to go through a similar procedure.
3. Buggies owned and operated by members must submit a copy of an insurance certificate providing 3rd party public liability each year when renewing their membership. This copy will be retained in the club administrators' office.
4. Any visitor bringing their own buggy must provide a copy of an insurance certificate providing 3rd party public liability before use of the buggy on the course is allowed. This copy will be retained in the club administrators' office.
5. All buggy drivers must be over the age of 16 years.
